Celumusa is the Principal Project Coordinator at Manzini Youth Care, a Salesian not for profit organization operating in Swaziland. He is currently managing 65 members of staff in 9 departments and directly supervises 9 Heads of Departments. He is responsible for setting the organization's strategy and direction, allocating capital to the organizations priorities amongst a number of other duties.

Celumusa has been part of the MYC story for a long time as he grew up in one of the homes (McCorkindales). There were tell-tale signs of his leadership strengths, he was the first from McCorkindales to be elected to the team of school prefects when he was in high school at St. Joseph's High School. Upon completion of his term he was bestowed with a n award for being the most well behaved prefect and overall best performer in the whole completing class.

Fate; upon completion of tertiary education, where he specialized in Business Administration, Celumusa accepted a job at The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award Swaziland, only to find that their offices are based in the same complex with those of MYC. He worked here for four and half years as Development Manager until he was promoted to the Director Position in 2012. Between 2009 and March 2013, celumusa doubled as a House Parent (Care Giver) for MYC. He was repeatedly asked to work each time, in one of the troubled homes, Ngwane Park and 6 months later he was asked to go quell the fires in another one, Sikhunyana, and later back where it all started, McCorkindales until March 2013.

January 2014, Celumusa was requested to come fully on-board at MYC, more especially to oversee the new establishment of MYC's latest big project, the Bosco Youth Agricultural Centre as Project Manager. He served in this position until November 2015 when he was promoted to General Manager of this project and recently to the current position, MYC Principal Project Coordinator.

Celumusa has ambitions to continue developing his knowledge and skills in Projects management and business leadership. He is a dedicated member of the MYC team and is very keen to see the young people in MYC's care succeed.
